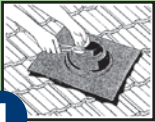


## Installation Information



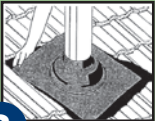
1

Trim the cone to suit pipe size using sharp tin snips.



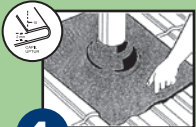
2

Slide down pipe using water as a lubricant.



3

Flatten the Dekform sheet and then place upper edge of base underneath the tiles to form a return edge.

Hand dress the apron for a professional finish with a perform hammer.

Lift sheet and apply spot adhesion technique using Z Bond Metal & Masonry Silicone V4.

### Available in Black and Grey EPDM or Red Silicone

EPDM will withstand constant temperatures at the roofline of -50°C (-122°F) to 115°C (239°F) & up to 150°C (302°F) intermittently.

Red Silicone will withstand constant temperatures at the roofline of -50°C (-112°F) to 200°C (392°F) & up to 250°C (482°F) intermittently.

## IMPORTANT WHEN INSTALLING

- Use PERFORM hammer to dress down leading edges.
- When installing Dekform we recommend ZBOND Metal & Masonry silicone V4 for adhesion.
- If painting is required, we recommend 100% Acrylic Low Sheen exterior paint for the Perform base.
- If painting is required for the Dektite the surface needs to be weathered for 3 weeks in its installed position then washed with warm water and prepared by coating with a small amount of mild solvent. Then apply 100% Acrylic Low Sheen exterior paint.
